Winners of their respective weight/bracket earn a slot in Sunday's competition. Winners must weigh in again for Sunday's competition. There will be a five-pound allowance, and qualifying wrestlers can weigh in directly after competition on Saturday.

Best of the Best: This is a true battleground for the hardcore wrestlers. Traditionally bracketed or modified round-robin – whatever can accommodate more or if needed. These brackets will be peppered with decorated and accomplished opponents. State Qualifiers or better get preference. If there are 4-8 wrestlers in a weight, we will form a modified round-robin bracket, anything other will be traditional bracketing. *FYI - Eight-man round-robins are two four-man groups with a cross-over.
